

So you've made an exciting, big decision to study in Perth, Western Australia!

Now that you have received your Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) from your Western Australian education provider of choice and confirmation of your student visa, it's time to prepare for your arrival in Perth.

This checklist highlights the compulsory items to bring:

- Student visa must be valid. Passport – must be valid for at least 6 months before your arrival in Perth. Other forms of identification - such as your driver's license and birth certificate. A copy of your Overseas Student Health Cover policy – also known as OSHC. Offer letter and Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) - and other relevant academic documents.
- Proof of payment for your tuition fees, OSHC, bank statements, etc.

To make your travels smoother, we also recommend bringing:

- Your flight itinerary to keep on hand for your convenience.
- Details of your accommodation this should be planned well in advance before your departure.
- Emergency contact details of your national embassy, accommodation provider, education provider, friends and family.
- Proof of COVID-19 vaccination as vaccination requirements can vary across airlines and other countries.
- A small amount of money in Australian currency for expenses before you set up an Australian bank account.
- Medical records and prescriptions if applicable.

Did you know Australia has strict biosecurity laws? It's important for you to check out the Australian Government website for a clear list on what food you can and cannot bring into Australia. If you arrive in Perth and are unsure if any items you have brought will be allowed, we recommend declaring it with customs or asking an Australian Border Force officer just in case.
